Special Birds of the Granitic Seychelles

These species are found only in the granitic Seychelles, nowhere else on earth. They are called endemic bird species. Conservation actions have saved the warbler and the magpierobin from the verge of extinction. Four species are still endangered with extinction as classified on the IUCN (the World Conservation Union) Red List of Threatened Animals. Nature Seychelles and other conservation partners are working together to improve their conservation status.



Seychelles Magpie-robin Copsychus sechellarum Distribution: Frégate, Cousin, Cousine and Aride Population: 168 birds. The species remains one the rarest birds in the world

Seychelles Kestrel Falco araea Distribution: Mahe and near by islands, Praslin, Silhouette, North Island and Felicite Population: about 450 pairs. The Seychelles Kestrel is the smallest **falcon** in the world



Seychelles Bulbul Hypsipetes crassirostris Distribution: Mahe, Praslin, Silhouette, La Digue and some small islands

Population: At least 20,000 birds

Seychelles blue pigeon Alectroenas pulcherrima Distribution: Breeds on most large and medium-sized islands including Aride and Cousin Population: At least 5,000 birds



Seychelles White-eye Zosterops modestus Distribution: Mahe, Conception, Frégate Population: About 400 birds

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Seychelles Sunbird Nectarinia dussumieri Distribution: Almost all the granitic islands Population: At least 20,000 birds



Seychelles Warbler Acrocephalus sechellensis Distribution: Cousin, Cousine, Aride and Denis Population: 3,500 birds



Seychelles Fody Foudia sechellarum Distribution: Aride, Cousin, Cousine, Frégate and Denis Population: About 4,000 birds



Distribution: Mahe Island Population: Up to 360 birds



Seychelles Swiftlet Aerodramus elaphrus Distribution: Mahe, Praslin and La Digue Islands Population: Between 2,500 and 3,000 birds



Distribution: La Digue Island

Population: About 230 birds

This is the only species of endemic birds in the granitic Seychelles that female and male have a completely different appearance.



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
